CONDITIONS OF ADMISSION:

Wilfrid Laurier University reserves the right to revise or rescind this Offer of Admission if the following conditions are not met by June 30, 2019:

- Acceptable evidence of English Proficiency (see requirements and options outlined at www.wlu.ca/epcondition)
- A minimum of six 4U/M courses, and an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).
- A minimum final average on six 4U/M courses of 87.0%, including prerequisites.
- . A minimum final grade of 80.0% in any 4U English course.
- A minimum final grade of 85.0% in MHF4U and MCV4U.

PROJECTED ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP: \$2000

Entrance scholarships are awarded based on the average of your best six 4U/M courses. Your average is calculated using your final grades as of June 30, 2018. In your upper years of study, \$500 - \$1500 is available annually in further scholarship funding to students who maintain a high academic standing through our In-Course Scholarship program. Scholarship eligibility requirements can be found at www.wlu.ca/studentawards. Please note that your projected entrance scholarship amount could change based on your final grades as of June 30 and that the average used for your entrance scholarship may be different from your admission average.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- · Laurier does not 'round up' averages.
- Final grades are received by Laurier from the Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC) in mid-late July. You are
 required to provide official English Proficiency test results or evidence of Level 5 LEAF registration by June 30, 2019. If
 the conditions, as stated above, are not met, you will be notified of a revised or rescinded offer in August.
- If, upon becoming aware of your final grades and/or English Proficiency results, you realize that your final conditions
 have not been met, please contact the Recruitment & Admissions office to discuss your options.
- If you confirm this Offer of Admission, you agree that Wilfrid Laurier University and the University of Waterloo may
 exchange application, biographical and academic information while you are registered in this Double Degree program.
